## Further Extension to the 'Grace Period' for Superannuation Benefits in respect of Teachers

- 1. I am directed by the Minister for Education and Skills to refer to Circular 32/2013 (primary teachers) and Circulars 0005/2014 and 0006/2014 (post-primary teachers) which state that a teacher who retires on or before 31 August 2014 will have his or her superannuation benefits calculated by reference to the pay scales and pensionable allowances applying to him/her on 30 June 2013. This 'Grace Period' was subsequently extended to the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2015 in Circular 0035/2014.
- 2. The Government has now decided to further extend the 'Grace Period' and consequently a teacher who retires on or before 30 June 2016 will have his or her superannuation benefits calculated by reference to the pay scales and pensionable allowances applying to him/her on 30 June 2013.
- 3. Please note that this circular letter supersedes Circular 0035/2014.
- 4. Please ensure that copies of this Circular are provided to all members of the Board of Management/ Education and Training Board and its contents are brought to the attention of all teachers in your employment including those on approved paid or unpaid leave.
