- All entries must be submitted on A3 (420 x 297mm) (Portrait or Landscape is acceptable).
- The entry can be drawn or painted in pencil, charcoal, pen or ink, felt-tip markers, crayon, pastel, water colours, gouache, acrylics, oils, poster colour or collage. Prints done from a lino block, wood block or any other method may also be submitted. No computer aided design (CAD) may be entered.
- It should be noted that once artwork is received by CPSMA, it becomes the property of CPSMA and may be reproduced at CPSMA's discretion.
- o It may be returned to the child at the discretion of CPSMA.
