- All entries must be accompanied by the CPSMA Entry Form, signed by a teacher/ facilitator as being the unaided and original work of the named child.
- All entries must be submitted on A3 (420 x 297mm) (Portrait or Landscape).
- An entry can be drawn or painted in pencil, charcoal, pen or ink, felt-tip markers, crayon, pastel, water colours, gouache, acrylics, oils, poster colour or collage. Prints done from a lino block, wood block or any other method may also be submitted. Computer aided design (CAD) will not be accepted.
- It should be noted that once artwork is received by CPSMA, it becomes the property of CPSMA and may be reproduced at CPSMA's discretion. We really love getting your entries, but unfortunately as we receive so many, we cannot return your art work.
- All entries are accepted as original works and CPSMA is not responsible for any breach of copyright.
- Entrants may only enter the competition once.
