Teacher Allocations and redeployment of surplus permanent/CID holding teachers

There are currently a total of **68 surplus permanent/CID holding teachers on panels for redeployment** to vacancies in other schools.

Schools had until Friday, 2 May 2014 to fill their vacancies through the redeployment process. **Panel Officers** are now being appointed to facilitate the redeployment of remaining surplus permanent/CID holding teachers.

The Department has liaised with the relevant panel operators and Panel Officers have been appointed to the following Catholic Dioceses; Cork, Cloyne, Dublin, Ferns, Kildare/Leighlin, Meath and Ross. The Department is currently liaising with other relevant panel operators for the appointment of Panel Officers for the remaining panels.

The Panel Officer process will commence with the school of the same patronage that is located nearest to the school with the surplus teacher.

Schools are also reminded that they are not permitted to commence a recruitment process to fill a permanent or fixed term teaching vacancy in any other manner until the Department is satisfied that vacant positions are not required for redeployment of any remaining permanent /CID holding teachers on a main panel. The timing of when teaching vacancies can be filled in any other manner will depend on how quickly permanent/CID holding teachers are redeployed into vacancies. The Department will publish regular panel updates on its website which will inform schools and teachers of progress being made on the redeployment of permanent /CID holding teachers.

Supplementary panels for the 2014/15 school year

Supplementary panels will be circulated at a later stage when the Panel Officer process has concluded for certain geographical areas that have all of the surplus permanent/CID holding

teachers redeployed in those areas. The details will be outlined in further panel updates which will be published on the Departments website.

The Department received over 2,550 applications from fixed-term, part-time and substitute teachers for inclusion on supplementary panels and expects to provisionally place up to 1,881 teachers on the supplementary panels. Teachers who applied for inclusion on the supplementary panels have been notified by the Department of the outcome of their applications.
